INDIVIDUAL REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- 1. Ruth's name doesn't appear in Hebrews 11, but her life mirrors the faith described there.
 - What qualities of faith do you see in Ruth that stand out to you personally?
 - Why do you think God chose someone so "ordinary" to play such an extraordinary role in redemptive history?
- 2. What stood out to you most in Ruth's decision to stay with Naomi rather than return to Moab?

- Ruth clung to Naomi—and ultimately, to Naomi's God—in a season of deep loss.
 - Can you recall a time in your life when you had to make a similar decision to stay faithful during grief or uncertainty?
 What helped you "cling" in that moment?
- 4. Ruth worked humbly and consistently in the fields—nothing glamorous, just faith in action.
 - What does this teach us about the nature of God's calling in our daily lives?
- 5. Naomi saw Ruth's faith as an opportunity for redemption.
 - Who has helped you see redemptive potential in your own story? Who can you encourage in the same way this week?
