	Luke 5:20
	Peace always precedes purpose.
2.	RESET HANDS WORK (vv. 18–19)
	Luke 5:18-19
	Faith is deeply personal, but it is never meant to be private.
3.	RESET HANDS JESUS'
	AUTHORITY (vv. 24–25)
	Luke 5:24-26
	Here's the truth: when your hands are RESET by Jesus, they are no longer just ordinary hands.
	WEEKLY APPLICATION STEP:
	This week, use your hands to bless one person in a practical way.
	Write a note of encouragement.
	Cook a meal.
	Help carry a burden (literally or figuratively).
	Serve in a way you never thought possible.
	Then ask God to show you: "How can I better serve you today?"

Questions for Further Study

1.	Why do you think Jesus addressed the man's sins before his paralysis? What does this reveal about God's priorities?
2.	Compare Luke 5:17–26 with Mark 2:1–12. What details are emphasized differently, and what does each Gospel writer want us to see about Jesus' authority?
3.	What does the Bible teach about forgiveness as the foundation of our service? (Consider Psalm 103:10–12, Romans 5:1, and Colossians 3:13.)
4.	Explore Galatians 6:2 ("Carry each other's burdens"). What does it look like in practice for the church to live this out?
5.	Study Matthew 28:18–20 in light of Luke 5:24–25. How does Jesus' authority shape both our mission and our everyday service?
