In a recent survey, 80% of Christians said they believe they have a personal responsibility to share their faith, but check this out:

- 46% have shared a Bible verse or story with a non-Christian loved one.
- 34% have invited a non-Christian loved one to a church event.
- 38% have explained how to become a Christian to a non-Christian loved one.
- 30% have shared how to become a Christian with a stranger.

3. Read Philippians 3:13–14. What’s something from your past (a failure, fear, or comfort) that you may be *clinging* to? How might letting go free you to live on mission more fully?
4. Jesus lived with clear direction — He “resolutely set His face toward Jerusalem.” What would it take for you to live with that same focus and determination in your walk with Him?
5. Have you ever mistaken being *busy* for being *faithful*? How can you tell the difference between the two, and what would it look like to simplify your life around God’s purpose?
