(Prices listed are an estimated cost per bag)

Donations of NEW undergarments for boys and girls of ALL ages are needed.

Babies ~\$80- Diapers (variety of smaller sizes), Wipes, Pacifiers, Swaddle Blanket, Non-Weighted Sleep Sack, Formula (12 oz or ready to use packs), Bottles, Diaper Cream

Toddlers: ~\$50- Diapers (variety of larger sizes), Pull-ups (variety of sizes), Wipes, Socks, Blanket, Diaper Cream, Stuffed Animal

K-5th grade ~\$35- Blanket, Stuffed Animal, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Deodorant, Socks, Chapstick

6-12th grade ~\$40- (no makeup) ~\$50- (with makeup) Blanket, XL hoodie, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Deodorant, Socks, Body spray/perfume, For girls: lip-gloss and mascara
