Before judgment falls, God secures His people.

## 1. The \_\_\_\_\_ Before Judgment.

Revelation 7:1-3

A pause does not mean God is absent.

## 2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Protection.

Revelation 7:2

In Ezekiel 9, God marked those who remained faithful to Him before judgment came upon Jerusalem.

Ephesians 1:13–14 says that when we believe the gospel, we are sealed with the promised Holy Spirit.

Nothing that happens to YOU can change the fact that you belong to God.

Revelation 7:4-8

(Theory #1) Some interpret the 144,000 literally.

(Theory #2) Other Christians understand the number symbolically.

God knows exactly who belongs to Him.

## Questions for Further Study

1. Revelation 6 ends with the question, “Who can withstand it?” and Revelation 7 begins with God securing His people before judgment continues. Why is it important that God marks His people before judgment moves forward?
2. “A pause does not mean God is absent.” Where have you experienced a season where God seemed silent or slow, but later you could see He was working?
3. Revelation 7 shows angels holding back the winds until God gives permission. What does this teach us about God’s authority over history, judgment, and the events of our lives?
4. The 144,000 has been interpreted in different ways by faithful Christians. Why is it helpful to acknowledge different views without losing sight of the main point of the passage?
5. Religious activity cannot place God’s seal upon us. We belong to God through faith in Jesus Christ. How can people confuse church activity with belonging to Christ?
